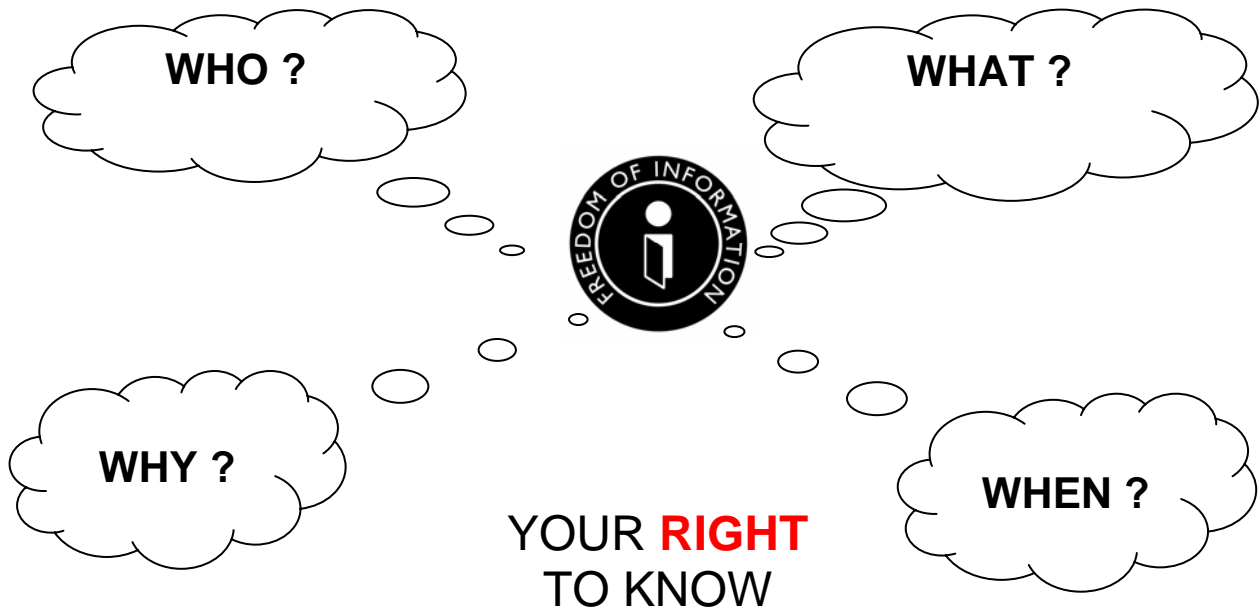


Freedom of Information



The Freedom of Information Act 2000 came into effect in UK law on 1 January 2005. By giving you access to our information, the Act will make us more accountable in the way we work to deliver services to you. You have the **right** to ask:-

“Do You **Hold** Information On?” “Can I **See** That Information ?”

Subject to any exemptions which apply, we are obliged to provide the information requested.* Freedom of Information requests must be made **in writing** and addressed to:
